The answer is : it depends on the type of lighter. According to the FAA, you can bring one lighter on your person or in your carry-on on a commercial flight if it contains flammable gas (like ...

I'd recommend placing the lighter in a place that is easily retrievable and not stuffed in the bottom of your carry-on bag just in case you need to remove it. You also don't want to risk it getting ...

Examples of effective measures to prevent unintentional activation include, but are not limited to: removing the battery from the lighter; placing the lighter into a protective case; and/or ...

Absolutely, you can carry a lighter on a plane but you are allowed to only take one lighter on board the aircraft with you. The lighter can either be in your carry on bag or in your pocket. But ... you must not ...

So can you take a lighter on a plane? The surprising answer to this question is yes. But only certain types of cigarette lighters are allowed on a plane, and only in some circumstances.
