Yes, but with reduced solar power output. Depending on the damage, the panel might: Continue producing electricity at a lower efficiency. Work partially if some cells remain operational. ...

Most solar cells will continue to produce a current even after they've been cracked. This current should still be usable, but your panel won't operate at maximum voltage.

Recent NREL studies show 23% of solar panel performance issues stem from physical damage, with electrical leakage occurring in nearly 1 of every 50 compromised panels.

Solar panel failure is extremely rare - less than 0.1% of all usage cases -- but they are still happening. Micro-cracks and hot spots reduce panel efficiency, creating damage.
