Mauritania will soon begin construction of a 220-megawatt hybrid power plant in Nouakchott under a public-private partnership, the Ministry of Energy announced on Wednesday.

On 12 September 2025, Mauritania signed a \$300 million agreement with renewable energy developer Ewa Green Energy to construct a 220-megawatt (MW) hybrid power plant near Nouakchott.

The 220-megawatt plant in Nouakchott will integrate 160 megawatts of solar photovoltaic capacity, a 60-megawatt wind farm, and a substantial 370-mWh battery energy storage system, all ...

Mauritania's major ports, such as Nouakchott, Nouadhibou, Ndiago, and Tanit, could greatly benefit from a consistent, renewable energy supply to power their operations.

With an investment of \$287 million, the project includes the construction of two renewable energy plants: a solar power plant in Nouakchott and a wind farm in Boulenouar.

Thermal power, already dominant in the electricity mix, is expected to play a central role in securing supply over the coming years. Authorities have confirmed progress on the expansion of ...
