Spain is preparing for an unprecedented expansion in battery energy storage and now ranks as the world's second-largest market for project development, behind only the United States.

Spain's EUR700 million program aims to boost battery storage capacity by adding 2.5 to 3.5 gigawatts, enhancing energy stability and supporting renewable integration. The initiative supports ...

- To ensure stable power supply, Spain plans to install 20GW of energy storage, favoring vanadium flow batteries for long-duration projects.

The project, sponsored by the Spanish government's energy research institute, CIUDEN, is scheduled to be completed in 16 months, with installation targeted for the second half of 2025.
